## Information for Parents

Objective: To reinforce reading comprehension, vocabulary building, and critical thinking by using novels in the classroom.

About the Choice Board: This ready-made literature choice board is ideal for use with any novel used in the 3<sup>rd-5th</sup> grade classroom. The board is derived from the multiple intelligences (which are listed at the bottom of each choice). The board is designed to allow teachers the flexibility to have the students complete three activities in a tic-tac-toe style, or to complete all nine activities.

MI: Multiple Intelligences

LO: Logical

LI: Linguistic

M: Musical

K: Kinesthetic

V: Visual

Materials: Other materials that will be needed to complete the activities on the choice board are: dictionaries, drawing or construction paper, colored pencils, index cards, old magazines, glue, photocopies of a page from the novel, watercolor paints (optional), paint brushes (optional), and cups of water (optional).
