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|  <p>Shadow Drawing<br/>Draw and compare a range of sizes (medium, large, tiny, massive etc.)</p> | <p>Draw the view from your bedroom window</p>   | <p>Create a ramp</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Using blocks or everyday items e.g. sturdy magazines/books create a ramp for your cars to drive up.</li> <li>How far can you make them launch?
